

## DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

NOVICE BOWLS (Monday and Fridays and Sun.)

Open Bowls (Mon., Tues., Wed., Sat.

OPEN PAIRS (Fridays)

- Convenor of the day uses tag board to draw names only for the day
- Play 10 ends, roll jack, respot rule
- No records kept

AUSSIE PAIRS (Saturdays)

- Convenor of the day uses tag board to draw names to establish teams for the day
- Play 10 ends, roll jack, respot rule
- The first player rolls 2 bowls, skips then roll 4 bowls, first player shoots remaining 2 bowls
- All shots are alternating with opponent
- No records kept

MENS/LADIES SINGLES TOURNAMENT (Women Wednesday (12 weeks) Men Friday (10 weeks)

- Convenor will draw matches from coloured tags in bowls
- Players will have a handicap based on colour tag (lead, vice, skip)
- 15 point games, roll jack, respot rule
- 2 points for a win, 1 point for a loss,
- Extra end for a tie
- Winner receives trophy

SURVIVOR CHALLENGE (Wednesday June 7 to August 23) (12 weeks)

- Convenor of the day organizes 3 ,4 or 5 person groups
- Tag board used to form groups by draw
- Cost a LOONIE (\$1) all monies paid out

- 3 and 4 player groups throw 4 bowls each with one bowl being removed each end (farthest away from the Jack including gutter and bowls out of bounds)
- 5 player groups throw 3 bowls each
- Respot rule
- Loser of end gets to roll jack and set mat next end
- Game is over when only 1 bowler is left with at least 1 bowl
- The winner of the groups will play again to determine winner
- No records kept , LOONIE payout

#### TAG LEAGUE (Thursdays June 15 – September 25 (12 weeks))

- As members arrive, Convenor will select member name tag from the tag board between 5:30 and 5:45 pm
- Convenor places tag in the same colour bowl as their name tag, colours represent lead, vice, skip positions
- Your tag colour is based on your choice for position preferred made on registration form
- At 5:45 pm tags are drawn to form teams for that game and night
- Team members can determine who play where for the game
- The skip tag is responsible for scoring and print team member names on the back of the card (recording of points for each person)
- Long jack rule in effect (jack will be set between 2 locations designated on greens.
- 3 points for a win, 2 points for a tie, 1 point for a loss
- After 12 weeks, awards will be for highest point winners and runners up for both men/women
- Games are 10 ends, if jack is out of bounds, respot at longest jack location as marked on greens.
- Tag league is for bowlers who do not want to be committed to a team or league for weeks.
- You come and bowl on Thursdays when you want over the 12 Thursdays as marked on the bowling calendar.

TEAM LEAGUE Tuesdays #1 June 26 to July 25 (6 weeks), #2 August 8 to September 12 (6 weeks)

- Members indicate on registration form if they want to participate
- Executive form teams drawing names by position
- Convenor sets conditions of play provided to each member outlining details of game
- 10 end games, respot rule, roll the jack
- 3 points for win, 1 point for loss plus one point for each end won for both teams
- 2 points for a tie
- These are set teams for each session or 6 weeks
- New teams formed for second session
- Play begins 6:00 pm
- Trophies to be awarded to highest points winners

NINE AND DINE (4 weeks)

- Activity planned for fun bowling and to promote fellowship for club members
- Offered 4 times in 2023
- June 8 – Forrest Cove Cup at the Cove
- August 10 second game at Forrest Lawn Bowling Club
- A new game to be introduced to both clubs
- Game takes less than 2 hours
- All players Home/Guests retreat to Jack Shack for light snacks/refreshments
- No cost or prizes
- July 23 and Sept.15, no details at this time
